OPERATION CROSSROADS THE LEGACY OF NUCLEAR TESTING AT BIKINI ATOLL



BIKINI ATOLL, one of the northernmost parts of the Marshall Islands archipelago, was selected by the United States as an ideal site for this area's atomic testing after World War II. In February 1946, Commodore Dan Egan of the U.S. Navy led with B-29's atomic bombs to Bikini. The purpose of the test was to determine the effects of nuclear war on the people and their environment.
